
II. 次の英文 TEXT 1, TEXT 2を読んで、後の問いに答えなさい。ただし、*のついた語句には、最後に〔注〕があります。

TEXT 1 高校生の Mei は、外国語学習に関する発表を行った。

I'm interested in Korean culture. I listen to Korean popular music every day, and watch Korean TV dramas and movies on weekends. I started learning Korean last year because I wanted to know more about the singers and actors I like. At first, learning the Hangul alphabet was difficult, but now I can read and write it. I feel very happy when I understand the things (①) my favorite singer is saying in Korean.

Are you interested in learning a foreign language *other than English? Look at *Chart 1. This *survey asked ②2,592 high school students on the internet, "Would you like to learn a foreign language other than English?" About 30% answered, "I would very much like to." or "I would like to." On the other hand, about 50% answered, "I *would rather not." or "I would not," and 15% answered, "I don't know." Only 5% answered, "I'm learning one." I was surprised to find that only about one *out of three students wanted to learn a foreign language other than English.




Next, look at Chart 2. The students who answered, "I would very much like to." or "I would like to." were asked, "What language would you like to learn?" The most popular language was Korean. About 35% answered that they wanted to learn it. About 20% answered that they wanted to learn Chinese.

More than half of the students chose these two languages. I think that we have more chances to communicate with Korean and Chinese people in Japan.

The *rest of the students chose European languages. About 15% chose French, and about 12% chose German. About 6% answered that they wanted to learn Spanish or Italian. I think that these students want to travel in European countries that have many popular places. Some students may want to visit famous museums, and others may be interested in sports in these countries (③) as soccer. About 5% gave other languages as their answer, and about 2% answered that they didn't know what language to learn.

Of course, English is a common language in the world today. It is used as a first or second language by over 1.5 *billion people globally. So, I ④[is / learn / it / to / that / important / believe] it. However, this doesn't mean we should *ignore other languages. Some people may think that we should learn only English and that we don't need to learn other languages, but I don't think ⑤ this is true. All languages are unique, and you can get new *perspectives by learning them. I know learning a foreign language ⑥ requires time and effort. But if you are interested in a foreign country, you should learn its language. You will understand its culture better if you know its language. With only a few words, you can start communicating with people there. I hope that you will start learning a language other than English someday. I am sure that it will change your view of the world.

TEXT 2 Mei の発表後に、同級生の James が感想を述べた。

I was born in London and moved to Korea when I was six years old. Then I came to Tokyo last year. From my own experience, I understand the importance of learning foreign languages.

I went to an international school in Korea, so I communicated with others in English at school. During my summer vacation, there was a festival in my town. At the festival, I met some Korean children. We played some games together, but I couldn't talk with them well because I couldn't speak Korean. I enjoyed the festival, but I felt sad, too.

Then I decided to study Korean. A few months later, I met them again, and I was able to talk with them in Korean. (⑦) After learning Korean, I realized that showing *respect to older people is important in Korea. Of course, I knew it was important, but I didn't know that it was so strongly *reflected in their language. If you learn the language <u>® speak</u> in a country that you're interested in, you will understand its culture better.

韓国の音楽やテレビドラマなどに興味があり、韓国語を学んでいるメイは、インターネットの調査データを紹介しつつ、外国語学習について発表した。半数以上の高校生が英語以外の外国語学習に意欲を示しているものの、実際に学んでいる生徒は30%程度しかいないことを説明した。またアジアの言語よりもヨーロッパの言語の人気が高かったことも紹介した。

ジェイムズは、イギリス在住時の韓国人との交流について、自らの経験を語った。その経験から、英語が韓国語に与えた影響について、年配の人たちとの対話から学んだことを紹介した。

自ら韓国語を学んでいるメイは発表の中で、インターネットの調査データにおいて、英語以外の外国語を学びたい高校生が半数以下と少ないことに驚いたと述べた。学びたい言語として韓国語を挙げた生徒が最も多かったことには喜びを示し、今後さらに多くの生徒が韓国語を学ぶようになるだろうと述べた。

ジェイムズは、韓国在住時の経験について語った。韓国で通っていた学校では 英語を話していたが、韓国の子どもたちと交流を図りたいと考え、韓国語の勉強 を始めた。その結果、外国語を学ぶことによってその国の文化を深く知ることが できるようになったと述べた。

メイは韓国文化が好きで韓国語を学んでいる。発表の中で、インターネットの調査データから、英語以外の外国語を学びたい高校生よりも、そうでない高校生の方が多いことを説明した。世界中で英語が話されている現在、そうした考え方を合理的であると考えるメイは、まずは英語の学習に力を入れるべきであるという考え方を提示した。

ジェイムズは、韓国在住時、学校でも日々の生活でも英語を使用していたが、コミュニケーションをとることにおいて大きな問題を経験しなかったと話し、日本における英語教育のさらなる充実の重要性について訴えた。

メイは韓国文化に興味があり、韓国語を学んでいる。発表の中で、インターネットの調査データを紹介し、英語以外の外国語を学びたい高校生が、そうでない生徒よりも少ないことを説明した。これに対して彼女は、言語を学ぶことで新たな視点を得られたり、文化をよりよく理解できたりすることを伝えて、英語以外の外国語を学ぶことを勧めた。
