II. 次の英文 TEXT 1, TEXT 2を読んで、後の問いに答えなさい。ただし、 \*のついた語句には、最後に〔注〕があります。

### TEXT 1 高校生で新聞部員の Mio は、睡眠に関する発表を行った。

How many hours do you sleep? When I was a junior high school student, I usually slept for about eight hours every night. But now I sleep for about six hours. I get up at six in the morning and leave home at seven. I usually take a train for about one hour to get to school. I get home at five in the evening and have dinner around six. After that, I start doing my homework. I usually finish it at nine or ten at night, and then I relax for a few hours. I read books, watch movies, or talk with my friends online. I go to bed at \*midnight. Since I started this \*routine, I sometimes feel sleepy at school.

Several weeks ago, I found a few articles about sleeping hours on the internet. One of the articles said that high school students should sleep for eight to ten hours to \*stay in good health. I was surprised to learn that we need to sleep so ( ① ). In another article, a doctor said that high school students need \*at least seven hours of sleep. Now I'm trying to change my daily routine and go to bed earlier.

I got ② [ in / sleep / many / students / hours / interested / other / how ]. So I talked about it at the last meeting of the newspaper club, and the club members decided to ask the students about it. Last week, we asked ③653 students at our school, "How many hours do you usually sleep?" Table 1 shows the results.

According to the results, 55 students answered that they sleep for less

than six hours, and 138 students answered that they sleep about six hours. This means that about 30 percent of the students don't get enough sleep. The other ( ④ ) students sleep at least seven hours, but only 141 of them sleep for about eight or more than eight hours. This means that only about 20 percent of the students get enough sleep to stay in good health.

According to the articles I read, if you don't get enough sleep, you may have many health problems. There are some examples of bad \*effects on Table 2. For example, without enough sleep, you cannot \*concentrate on your work or remember things well. Also, you may get sick more easily and even get serious diseases.

After learning all of this, I can say that getting enough sleep is one of the most important things for all of us. If you sleep less than seven hours every night, you should try to go to bed half an hour earlier than \*usual. <a href="#style="text-align: center;">5 This</a> will help you concentrate more on your studies and get better \*grades. I hope you enjoy a healthy school life.

## TEXT 2 Mio の発表後に、同級生の Sophie が感想を述べた。

Mio, thank you for your interesting speech. I often feel sleepy during classes. I usually sleep for six hours on \*weekdays, but I sleep for eight hours on weekends. I wanted to know about the sleeping routines of other students. So, I asked three friends of mine about it.

David gets up at six in the morning and goes to bed at eleven at night

every day. He runs in the park every morning and does some exercise before going to bed. He likes to <u>⑥ keep regular hours</u>. Kenta gets up at seven in the morning on weekdays and at nine on weekends. He usually goes to bed at midnight. He said that he feels good on weekends, but that he feels tired on Mondays. Sakura gets up at seven thirty in the morning on both weekdays and weekends. She goes to bed at eleven at night on weekdays and at twelve thirty at night on weekends. <u>( ⑦ )</u> so she needs to get up early even on weekends.

I've heard that it's good for us to keep regular hours. I feel good after I sleep longer, but Kenta feels tired. I'm going to do some more research on people's sleeping hours. I'd like to share it with you later.

J. 睡眠時間に関して、TEXT 1と TEXT 2の両方の文章に即して説明するものとして、最も適切なものを一つ選び、その番号を書きなさい。

ミオの所属する新聞部の調査データによると、約7時間眠ると答えた生徒の数が最も多く、次に約6時間眠ると答えた生徒の数が多かった。ミオは、自分が十分な睡眠時間を確保できているとは考えておらず、通学途中や授業中に眠くなってしまうことがよくあると発表の中で述べた。

ミオの発表を聞いたソフィーは、自らの経験を紹介した。ミオよりも平均して2時間長い睡眠時間をとってはいるものの、やはり授業中に眠くなってしまうことがあることを説明した。今後、より良い睡眠について友人たちに相談するつもりであることを伝えた。

ミオの所属する新聞部の調査データによると、半数以上の生徒の睡眠時間が7時間以上であることがわかった。一方で、睡眠時間が6時間に満たない生徒が全体の約8%ほどいたこともわかった。ミオは、睡眠不足の与える影響の例を提示し、十分な睡眠をとることは最も重要なことの一つであると言い、聞き手に十分な睡眠時間をとるように訴えた。

ミオの発表を聞いたソフィーは、自分と友人たちの睡眠時間について情報を 共有した。ソフィー自身は、より長く眠ると調子が良いと感じると述べるも、 友人のケンタはそうではないことを説明した。

ミオの所属する新聞部の調査データによると、半数以上の生徒の睡眠時間が、7時間に満たないことがわかった。また6時間未満しか眠っていない生徒の割合も、10%を超えており、ミオは大きな問題としてとらえていると伝えた。さらに、集中力の低下や体力の低下といった、睡眠不足が人に与える悪影響について紹介し、聞き手により長い睡眠時間を確保するように訴えた。

ミオの発表を聞いたソフィーは、日ごろから睡眠時間について関心を持っており、つい先日も友人たちと話題に取り上げたことを共有した。その中で、いかに短い時間で質の高い睡眠をとるかが大きな課題であると述べた。

ミオの所属する新聞部の調査データによると、約7時間以上眠る生徒の数は、7時間未満しか眠らない生徒の数より多いことがわかった。ミオは日ごろから、高校生に必要な睡眠時間が8時間から10時間であると考えており、まだまだ生徒たちの睡眠時間が短いと考えている。そのため、短い睡眠時間が人に与える悪影響について紹介し、睡眠時間をさらに長くするよう、聞き手に訴えた。

ミオの発表を聞いたソフィーは、睡眠時間について日ごろから考えていることについて述べた。睡眠時間を長くとることは重要であるが、同様に睡眠の質を高めることに高い関心を持っており、そのことについてミオがどのように考えているかを尋ねた。
